Re.: Message to the Province after the Chapter 2008

Dear Brothers,

May the Lord give you His Peace!

After the closing of your Provincial chapter of 2008 I would like to wish you and to your Province the help of the Holy Spirit to carry out the decisions of the Chapter and to make this event fruitful in your life.

In the General Definitory, we have reflected upon the final report about your Chapter. Let me share with you some of the things that seem to me to be important as you start this three-year period.

It seemed to us that you were living in a difficult period in the development of your society: with growing welfare, consumerism is likely to corrode traditional values. In this situation I would like to confirm your resolution to look at our world always as **men of faith**: it is only in this that we can discover how to live a Gospel life today. Our life "hidden with Christ in God" (Col 3:3) is therefore the point of departure for the discernment of the ways that lead us into the future.

As you are trying to discern what the Lord is asking of you, a generous response is never lacking on your behalf. What needs discernment is whether you will be able to carry on all the various tasks that you have undertaken in the service of the People of God. It will be inevitable to set up a **priority** in these tasks, to be able to regroup your forces and to maintain the good level of your service.

In recent years, in fact, reflection in our Order has given us the basic insight that the three elements of fraternity, contemplation and mission are connected in a fundamental way. For your discernment, I would like to underline his profound interconnection. As you speak about your life experience in permanent formation meetings, try to reflect regularly on this interconnection of fraternity, contemplation and mission – never any of these without the other two. It is often the link between **fraternity and mission** that has hearings on leadership decisions. I wish you the courage to make these when they seem inevitable.

In the name of the whole Order, I thank you for the very important help that you are giving to our presence in Libya. Besides offering personnel, the transmission of fraternal life and formation is crucial in terms of assuring a background to friars working there. I sincerely hope that your provincial fraternity will be able to keep up this commitment and fill the existing agreement with a rich content.

I would like to mention a specific aspect of our witness in fraternity. Friars around the world are trying to live poverty in today's circumstances with a particular stress on transparency and solidarity. It is becoming an insight shared by all friars that any solidarity with the poor must begin with solidarity among the members of the House or the Province. I would like to encourage you to live up to the radical expectation that our legislation holds up to us in this respect.

Let me close this fraternal message with a reminder about the pastoral care of vocations. Do not cease to offer our charism, for the young people who come to you with their questions. Be always ready to propose them the beautiful ideal of Gospel life that once touched your hearts and is still animating your vocation. Share with them the joy of following Christ!

May the Lord guide you with His Spirit on your way and enlighten your heart. We know that he has been faithful to his promises, and we know he is the one who "creates all things anew". Remaining faithfully in communion with him, our steps will never go astray.



Fonti għall-Hajja ta' Sant' Antnin ta' Padova

Fonti għall-Hajja ta' Sant' Antnin ta' Padova, traduzzjoni mill-original Latin ta' Noel Muscat OFM u Gużepp Benedikt Xuereb OFM, introduzzjonijiet, apparat kritiku u indiči ta' Noel Muscat OFM, edizzjoni TAU, Patrijet Franġiskani, Malta 2008, pp.555, ISBN 978-99932-0-595-1.

Fis-sensiela ta' pubblikazzjonijiet tal-Fonti medjevali tal-ħajjet ta' qaddisin Franġiskani, wara ż-żewġ volumi dwar il-*Fonti għall-Hajja ta' San Franġisk* u l-volum dwar il-*Fonti għall-Hajja ta' Santa Klara*, issa jmiss dan il-volum dwar il-Fonti Bijografiċi għall-Hajja ta' Sant' Antnin ta' Padova (1195-1231).

Il-Fonti għall-Hajja ta' Sant' Antnin huma dokumenti medjevali dwar wieħed mill- aktar qaddisin popolari tal-kristjanita, miktubin minn patrijet li kienu jafuh, jew minn dixxipli tagħhom, bejn l-1232 u t-tmien is-seklu 14. Huma xhieda tal- għerf kbir tad-duttur Evangeliku Sant' Antnin, għax jipprezentawh bħala predikatur u qaddis li jwettaq għeġubijiet, l-aktar fl-ambjent ta' Padova fejn qatta' l-aktar snin importanti ta' ħajtu. Fl-istess hin jitkellmu dwar l-origini tiegħi fir-renju tal-Portugall, l-ewwel bħala Fernando ta' Lisbona, kanonku regolari ta' Santu Wistin, u mbgħad bħala Fra Antnin, li jissahħar mis- semplici ta' l-ewwel Patrijet Minuri li ghaddew minn Coimbra biex imorru l-Marokk, fejn mietu martri fl-1200.

Juru lil Antnin bħala missjunarju fl-Afrika ta' Fuq, nawfragu fuq ix-xtut ta' Sqallija, patri mhux magħruf fil-kapitlu ta' l-Għid il-Hamsin tal-1221, eremita fuq Monte Paolo, predikatur li juri l-gherf tiegħi fil-belt ta' Forli. Juruh bħala ghalliem tat-teoloġija f' Bologna, bħala kustodju tal-patrijet f' Limoges, u bħala ministru provinċjal f' Padova. Fuq kolloks, huma dokumenti ta' valur kbir rigward il-kult li nghata lill-qaddis mill-poplu sempliċi, sa mill-ewwel mumenti wara l-mewt tiegħi fil-monasteru tal-Klarissi ta' Arcella, qrib Padova fit-13 ta' Ĝunju 1231. Huma dokumenti li nkitbu mill-ewwel wara l- kanonizzazzjoni ta' Antnin fi żmien record ta' biss 11- il xahar mill-mewt tiegħi, u li saret mill-Papa Girgor IX fit-30 ta' Mejju 1232.

Din hi t-tielet opra li l-Franġiskani Maltin qegħdin jipprezentaw fis-sensiela ta' volumi ta' dokumenti Franġiskani medjevali, li jikkommoraw il-25 anniver- sarju mit-twaqqif ta' l-Edizzjoni TAU (1982-2007) u jipparaw iċ-ċelebrazzjoni tat-800 sena mill-fondazzjoni ta' l-Ordni tal-Patrijet Minuri (1209-2009).

B' hekk nistgħu ngħidu li issa għandna f'idejna t-tradizzjoni bil-Malti tal-Fonti medjevali ewlenin ta' l-iktar tliet qaddisin importanti ta' l-Ordni Franġiskan. Ta' min jgħid li hu biss fil-lingwa Taljana li dawn il-Fonti dwar Sant' Antnin ġew tradotti kollha.

Ix-xogħol tat-traduzzjoni sar minn P. Noel Muscat OFM u P. Ġużepp Beneditt Xuereb OFM, li ma laħaqx ra din l-opra stampata, għax miet fil-11 ta' Ottubru 2007. Il-volum hu għalhekk ukoll att ta' gratitudni għall-ħidma li għamel P. Ġużepp Beneditt b'risq il-Provinċja Franġiskana Maltija u l-Ordni tal-Patrijiet Minuri. Il-volum fiż-żebi preżentazzjoni minn P. Raymond Camilleri OFM, li hu l-fundatur ta' l-edizzjoni TAU.

Fir-reċensjoni li l-istudjuż P. 

The General Board of Definitors meets the Conference of Asia and Oceania

From September 20 – 24, the General Board of Definitors met with the Conference of East Asia, South Asia, Australia, and Oceania, as requested by the General Chapter. The meeting with all the representatives of the entities present in two continents took place in Bangkok, Thailand. In addition to the General Minister and his board of definitors, there were also present 22 other members (Ministers, Custodians, and two secretaries).

On the first day, the Minister and his board visited our presence in Lamsai. The General met with the friars who live in Thailand; it is a new presence in the Order that is growing with vocations from the local area and offers encouraging prospects. In the morning of the 21st, a solemn celebration presided by Cardinal of Bangkok remembered the 8th centennial of the Order. Then, a busy moment for everyone ensued with a visit to “St. Clare’s home”, where the sick stricken with Aids are cared for. The meeting between the Definitors and the Conference took place at the “Pastoral Center of the Bangkok Archdiocese”; it is a big and very comfortable structure offering space for every need for this event, such as accommodation, a chapel, halls, and a beautiful garden surrounded by flowers and fountains. The meeting, which was admirably prepared, had its first session with the presentation of all entities (Provinces/Custodies), followed by a speech by the General Minister with an opportunity for dialogue regarding future challenges. Not even a history and religious approach to Thailande culture was lacking after participating at a cultural show and a historical view of the Royal Palace.

Lithuania – V Congress of European Lithuanian Franciscan Youth

Preparations for the V Congress of European Franciscan Youth will take place in Lithuania from Aug. 18 – 24, 2009 with the theme, “From Martyrdom to Resurrection”.

For Franciscan Lithuanian youth, it will be a great honor to welcome other Franciscan youth in their country of Lithuania which commemorates a thousand years to its name in their Capital of Vilnius, the European Capital of Culture 2009. This Congress will be a true event, especially for Franciscan youth of Europe because it will happen during the VII centennial celebration of the birth of Franciscan charism. Hungary – General Chapter SFO

From November 15 – 22, 2008, the Secular Franciscan Order will celebrate its 12th General Chapter in Hungary. It will be an elective chapter and will conclude the period of two years dedicated to the VIII Centennial of the birth of St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Great Britain – 7th Centennial of the Death of Duns Scotus

The Province of the Immaculate Conception in Great Britain continues to develop the program of initiatives promised for the 7th Centennial of the death of Blessed John Duns Scotus.

On September 14, there was a Eucharistic celebration in honor of the Blessed presided by the Archbishop of St. Andrews, Cardinal Keith O'Brien, in the Cathedral of St. Mary in Edinburgh, Scotland. Present at the celebration were also the Archbishop of Glasgow, Mario Conti, Fr. Henry Doherty and many other Friars. The homily was delivered by Fr. Michael Copps OFM, Provincial Minister. On Sept. 6, the international day of study on Duns Scotus was celebrated at the International Franciscan Institute of Studies under the auspices of the Center of Studies of Franciscan History in Canterbury. The speakers were Dr. Thomas Mollenbeck, Dr. Anonie Vos, Dr. Ed Ondrako, OFM Conv., and Dr. Seamus Mulholland, OFM; it was directed by Fr. Philippe Yates, OFM, person in charge of the Center.

On November 13, there will be a Holy Mass at the International Center of Studies celebrated by Fr. James Mc Curry, OFM Conv., who is the General delegate of the Delegation of OFM Conv. for Great Britain and Ireland. Fr. Edward Ondrako, OFM Conv., will preach for that event, whereas Dr. Thomas Mollenbeck of the University of Paderborn will preach at the annual conference on Duns Scotus entitled “1308 – 2008 John Duns Scotus: A Man for All Seasons”.

Belgium – Program of Franciscan Missionary Formation.

On Sept. 1 in Brussels the course of Franciscan Missionary Formation began with the presence of 12 missionaries (4 Conventuals, 6 Capuchins, and 2 Friars Minor). Given the circumstance, the local Fraternity “grew” because of the presence of the secretary of the OFMConv missions, Fr. Jarek (who stayed for more than two weeks) and of Fr. Larry Webber, Capuchin (who is a permanent member of the group of Formators for the duration of the course). In the month of September, the course will focus on building an intercultural Fraternity. Therefore, the lessons will be about intercultural dynamics, spirituality of the missions, the history of Franciscan missions, and the realization between mission and word of God. In October, lessons on Franciscan missionary theology will be offered with themes such as “justice, peace, integrity of the created” and African culture. The month of November will be dedicated to Asian culture, some practical questions, such as management of the economy. For the conclusion of the course of formation, there will be a moment of spiritual high, i.e., going on retreat/a pilgrimage to Franciscan sanctuaries of the Reatine valley, of Assisi, and la Verna.

Initiatives of Permanent Formation of the Brazilian Conference

The ministry for Formation and Studies of the OFM Brazilian Conference has promoted two interesting experiences of permanent formation. The first so called “Experience Reliving the Gift of Vocation” saw the participation of about 30 friars in the month of July and August with a pilgrimage to the Franciscan places in Italy and the Holy Land. The second one occurred from September 7 – 22 in two places inhabited by indigenous people in the regions of the Amazon, where friars less than 10 years of solemn profession had a mission experience. Both experiences have been very positive and have encouraged the friars to have ample time to renew the gift of their vocation and mission.

Teutopolis, USA – Celebrating 150 Years of Franciscan Presence

Many Friars and friends gathered together the evening of September 14, 2008, to celebrate 150 years since the arrival of the Friars Minor in Teutopolis, Illinois; it was the first phase of the foundation of the Province of the Sacred Heart of St. Louis – Chicago in the USA. After the greeting of the Provincial Minister, Fr. M. Perry, and special thanks to the General Minister, Fr. Jose R Carballo and his General Difinitior, Fr. F. McGinn for their presence at this important event of the Province, the celebrations were then begun with the intonation of the official hymn of the Jubilee. A moment of prayer then ensued, leading up to the inauguration of a power point presentation on the history of the Province.

September 15 began with a speech from the General Minister who, once having presented the vision of the Order, invited everyone to discern our life and work according to the priorities of the Order. Above all, he encouraged the Friars to embark decisively on the road of collaboration with other Franciscan entities present in the United States in order to face the great challenges of the present and be authentic signs of fraternity.

The celebration of the Eucharist then followed in the Church of Saint Anthony, presided by the General Minister with the participation of more than 100 friars. Present also were the bishops Robert Hermann of the Archdiocese of Saint Louis and George Lucas of the Diocese of Springfield. At the end of the celebration, the General Minister gave each Friar a copy of the rule of the Friars Minor, and he received, in turn, another copy signed by all the Friars of the Province of the Sacred Heart.

Franciscan Bookmark

Vena vivida – Lebendige Quelle“. Texte zu Klara von Assisi und ihrer Bewegung (Texts on Clare of Assisi and her movement), Vol. I., Norderstedt 2008, pp. 209.

The very important process of canonization of St. Clare of Assisi has been handed down to us only in an Italian version of XIV century. Because of the unforeseen illness of the editor, the last part of the process is missing. Some texts in German and Dutch can convey some elements of this process and propose very interesting considerations on the first interpretation of Clare, especially in the German language. The series “Vena Vivida” is the first collection and translation of the ancient texts in the German language regarding Clare. All the texts are presented with introductions, bibliographical references, and notes properly arranged, thus offering us a multicolored vision of the early Clarian tradition. Fr. Johannes Schneider OFM (Telfs/Austria) has put together the texts that are foreseen for the new collection of the sources in the German language on Clare of Assisi.

The written or dictated prayers of Saint Francis are the most important points of reference to know what his relationship with God was like. This book has for its aim the study of these prayers through a detailed analysis of them; and they allow us to discover the saint as a true practical master of prayer. Additionally, the “practice of a *lectio divina* of the prayers of Saint Francis” and the bibliography that this book offers, make them a useful tool for a deep personal reflection and a valuable help for courses, seminars, and retreats on the prayers of Saint Francis. The sisters of St. Clare of Assisi Federation of the Poor Clares of Umbria – Sardegna have responded to the appeal of the Custos of the Holy Land, Delegate of the Latin Patriarch, ordinary of the Monastery of St. Clare of Jerusalem, to help that community with new sisters. After a careful discernment by each community, on Sept. 22, 2008, the first two sisters departed for Jerusalem. Among them was Sr. C. Cristiana Ianni by decree of CIVCSVA; she will be in charge with the progress of the elective chapter that will take place in Jerusalem when all the sisters are expected to be gathered there. In the upcoming months, four other sisters will also follow suit; among them will be two from the Monastery of St. Clare of Kamonyi – Rwanda.

Ad limina Petri ‘cum Francisco’ post octingentos annos: This is an initiative which we propose to the Friars of the Franciscan family as a concrete sign of restitution- by word and example – to the Lord for calling us to himself, the Church, and the brotherhood. In other words, it will be a way of celebrating 800 years of the birth of the Order and giving back all that we have received from Divine Providence by reaching by foot, through a **poor itinerary**, our mother, the *Holy Roman Church*, and communicating to the Supreme Pontiff what the Lord has done through us (3 Comp 46). This project, which will take place around the Chapter of Mats and which foresees a personal encounter with the Pope in Rome in its second phase on April 18, 2009, will last for 40 days (March 10 – April 18). It will be carried out by foot by 12 friars who will be departing from an undetermined, but significant place of Puglia, Italy (e.g. the Grotto of St. Michael the Archangel), while stopping along the way in those communities that will welcome us to announce the Gospel with *few and simple words* (Test. 2). This will also be in tune with *The Year of St. Paul* proclaimed by Benedict XVI with the aim of a renewed form of evangelization.

Aware that this will take place during the seasons of Lent/Easter, yet encouraged by such an unrepeatable proposal, we ask all the brothers willing to undertake this type of journey to send your support of this project no later than November 29, 2008, to establish meetings of formation, programming, and of social contact. In this way, we will be able to relive that itinerant spirit according to the *Legend of the Three Companions*.
